Adventure Tours Australia provides a range of camping options for its camping safari portfolio:

- Deluxe 'Safari in Style' campsite
- Permanent campsite
- Semi permanent campsite
- Bush campsite – with swags
- All passengers are able to experience the swag (great Aussie bedroll)

Adventure Tours Australia, from the outset, has committed to building quality campsites and negotiating premium arrangements with commercial campground suppliers, to gain the following benefits:

Adventure Tours is committed to maintaining our campsites to a high quality standard, employing staff at Yulara and Darwin for this purpose. Our relationships with campsite landowners are long term and strong.

Over recent years we have undertaken several major upgrade projects, refurbishing existing campsites and building further campsites.

Adventure Tours was successful in gaining an Australian Development Tourism Grant in late 2007 from the Federal Government of \$100,000 to refurbish existing and build deluxe twin share campsites at Yulara and along the Alice Springs <-> Darwin touring route. (see attached Campsites2008.doc).

We believe it would cost approximately \$2.5 million to replace our current campground infrastructure (as estimate for our campsite insurance cover)



'Safari in Style' campsites offer deluxe twin share camping (Central Australia) or deluxe twin / double camping (Top End). The large tents have standard beds, are made up with pillows, linen, blankets and a towel, a fan, lighting and a bedside table.

The 'Safari in Style' screened kitchen / dining area is equipped with china plates, glassware, refrigeration, hot water, fans and cooking facilities. Purpose built fire pit. Shared shower and toilet facilities.



Permanent campsites offer twin and four share camping. The tents have built in beds with a vinyl covered mattress, sleeping bags can be hired. The permanent campsite screened kitchen / dining area is equipped with refrigeration, hot water, overhead fans and cooking facilities. Purpose built fire pit. Shared shower and toilet facilities.



Semi-permanent campsites – pop-up tents are erected by guide and passengers, most wish to experience the authentic ‘swag’ experience under the stars. Yulara sites have power supply, screened kitchen / dining area equipped with refrigeration, hot water, fans & cooking facilities. Purpose built fire. Shared shower and toilet facilities.
